The last few months have been very busy for the Post.

First, **Rick Raskin** and I meet with the attorney regarding the rezoning of our property to B-3 so we could expand the building on the south side (towards the firehouse). We discovered after consulting the attorney, it would be to cost prohibitive to do the rezoning and expansion. We would have to pave the parking lot; then we would have to concern ourselves with storm water run-off; and have to install lights in the parking lot. These additional requirements would put the cost over a \$175,000.

We revisited the project with the attorney and Gregory construction company. We are considering put the expansion on the backside of the building. There are still obstacles to overcome, but we feel this will keep the building costs in line with what we have budgeted for the expansion.

Secondly, I want to thank SVC **Peter MacLeod** for organizing the school visit this year. Along with the assistance of Past Commander **Jerry Martin**, the school visit at Mayfield Middle School was a great success. Jerry recruited three WWII veterans who spoke with to the children. I would like to take this opportunity to say "Thank You" to the chairmen and members of the Ladies Auxiliary for all the assistance during the Fall Jubilee, Yard Sale and CiCi's fund-raisers. The Ladies Auxiliary would like to "Congratulate" June Childress as the winner of the Cancer Aid & Research basket.

During the recent National Convention, a Resolution was brought before the membership and passed to increase the National dues from \$3.50 to \$5.00 per member effective January 1st, 2012. Our annual dues are \$15, with a one-time \$5 initiation fee for new members. On January 1, our Annual Dues breakdown will be as follows: \$5.00 National Dues + \$5.50 State dues = \$10.50; this leaves a balance of \$4.50 for the Auxiliary General Fund. \$2.60 of the \$4.50 remaining is used to pay the following requirements per member: 35 cents for District Dues, \$2.00 for National's Cancer Aid & Research Program and 25 cents for the VFW National Home for Children Health & Happiness Fund. This leaves a balance of \$1.90 per member for the Auxiliary General Fund. If we increase dues to \$20, the remainder gives us \$6.90 per member to pay requirements, leaving a balance of \$4.30 for each member. As you can see, increasing dues will improve our General Fund. Initiation fee would remain \$5. At our December 5th meeting, we will discuss increasing our dues to \$20.00.
