We are working with WAA to place more wreaths than ever before on Veterans' graves at Quantico National Cemetery. We ask for your support because this is a major fund-raiser for the Auxiliary. Last year we sponsored 299 wreaths and this year our goal is at least 500. Sponsorships are \$15 per wreath. # Hall Rentals

Hall rentals are going very well this year with most weekends seeing at least one of two days taken. We've had sweet 16 parties, baptismal parties, wedding receptions and graduation parties among others. We also are seeing increased rentals within the Hispanic community as word of our facility spreads.

We also have several groups that use the hall on a regular basis. One of them, The Greater Way of Life Ministry conducts services and has a weekly bible study. We have an arrangement where they provide floor maintenance in lieu of rental fees. This is a good deal for the post based on what we have paid others in the past.

Post members may rent the hall for discounted rates. Renewed annual members, starting in their second year of membership, enjoy half price rentals. Life members may rent the hall for a donation to the post. There is a refundable security deposit required with all rentals; \$150.00 if alcoholic beverages are not to be served, \$300.00 if they are.
